January 15th General Meeting:

Meeting called to order at 7:18 P.M. Minutes for November 20, 2008 were read and approved.

Rod Rinta provided the entertainment for the evening. Rod discussed fishing as a back-seater on the F.L.W. pro circuit and covered a lot of do's and don'ts of being a successful fisherman. From pre-fishing, to equipment needs, to etiquette. It was very informative, and we appreciate his talk.

Adjourned for a break at 8:20 resumed at 8:37.

Chris Blandi's Treasurer's report showed a balance of \$2635.75 with many membership renewals coming in tonight. Don't forget to get your renewal in, to avoid the late fee.

Next fish-in is this coming Saturday at Lake Washington...February fish-in will be the first weekend in Feb. at Lake Sammamish, details to follow...

Tournament Director: Phil Hudgens reported that Sites have been reserved for all three of our club events at Coulee Playland...BUT it is VITAL that you call and put in your name as a member of Western Bass Club. The National Qualifier is the same weekends so don't be left out! Silver Lake is April 11th which will be the same days as the Mt. St. Helen's Open.

Nick Barr announced that next month we will have Jeff Boyer as our entertainment.

Special Events is the Sportsman's Show there are still a few spots open, check the web site.

Angie received two green slips for the month: Brian 2.8lb American Lake on a Drop Shot-Tiny Brush Hog, and Jose's 3.0lb Lake Washington-Hula Grub.

Old Business:

There was much discussion on the rule for off limits on tournament waters, and also the rule allowing tournament changes only in the month of November.

A proposal was made to amend the rule for tournament changes, to allow them to be changed during any non-tournament month, not just in November. This would allow for updates and modifications to be made without disrupting the current tournament schedule. This was proposed by Mark Maderos, and will be discussed in February again and voted on in March.

The second proposal was made by Chris to amend the off limits days for tournament waters, to allow members to fish on those waters at any time. This would go into effect for the upcoming year, if the first proposal is approved, since it is still in the by-laws to limit the lake pre-fishing to a week before a tournament. Again this will be discussed further at the February meeting, and voted on in March.

These are important issues that need to be *seriously* considered, so the opinions and thoughts, and VOTES of all members would be appreciated!

Membership dues: It was voted on and passed to raise the annual dues to \$45.00. This will eliminate the need for the fund raising raffle, and keep our club liquid. That way we can spend more time talking fishing.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:27 P.M.

Take I-5 South to West 16 and head over the Narrows Bridge. N on SR 16, exit at Sedgwick Rd, go E 2.5 mi; R on Long Lake Rd SE; go .4 mi; R on Clover Valley Rd, go 1.1 mi. These are the directions from the Fish and game website.
